

# PTC Meeting Minutes: 09/19/17

6:05pm Meeting called to order by Brandi Comeaux.

Approval of Minutes – Anna Elledge. Verbal recap of minutes from open house presented. Motion was presented by Brandon Cooper and second was received...minutes were approved.

Brandon Cooper presented the Treasurer's Report: As of 08/31/17, there is \$47,406.26 in the general fund. The Lemonade Fundraiser from open house made a profit of \$50.00.

Old Business:
